



Postdoctoral Psychology Residency Program Information Tables

The goal of CHCI's Postdoctoral Psychology Residency program is to train the next generation of psychologists in the Patient Centered Medical Home model with locations across the state. Residents are given a stipend of \$50,000 and benefits include medical, dental and vision insurance, continuing education reimbursement and generous paid time-off. All residents will be expected to focus on outpatient clinical treatment in the primary care and behavioral health clinic settings with all age ranges. Specialized experiences, including shelter-based and school-based work, are available at most sites. Residents will fine-tune therapy skills through weekly seminars, quality improvement projects, research, collaboration, group and individual supervision and clinical work with diverse, under-served populations.

Applicants must have completed their doctoral academic coursework at an APA accredited graduate program. To be considered for the residency program all requirements for the doctoral degree must be completed before starting the postdoctoral training program and an internship that is APA accredited or one that meets APPIC standards. These requirements will be verified by CHC staff.
